Update On The Status Of The Community Economic Betterment Account (CEBA) Program

ISSUE

During FY 1994 the CEBA Program awarded all funds available (\$3.3 million) from the original allocation within the Strategic Investment Fund (SIF) appropriation, received \$400,000 in an appropriations transfer, and received a supplemental appropriation of \$3.7 million, for a total of \$7.4 million in FY 1994 funding. Additionally, the General Assembly appropriated \$5.7 million for FY 1995 to the SIF of which approximately \$5.0 million has been allocated for CEBA. The General Assembly also mandated several changes in the CEBA Program.

BACKGROUND

The CEBA Program provides funding for companies creating and retaining jobs in Iowa. The funds are intended to be only a small portion of a financial package, with the majority of the investment coming from private and local public sources. Cities, counties, and merged area school districts are eligible to apply on behalf of local enterprises that are expanding, or businesses that are relocating into the State. The Program provides loans and forgivable loans.

Key criteria for approval of applications are:

- Number and quality of jobs created or retained.
- Cost per job for CEBA funds in the project.
- Significant other public and private financial involvement.

The funds can be used for building construction or remodeling, purchasing machinery and equipment, a limited amount of working capital, or assistance with other business financing.

The CEBA Program began in FY 1986 with initial funding coming from Lottery revenues. The level of funding has ranged from a high of \$10.5 million in FY 1986 to a low of \$3.3 million in FY 1993. The demand for the Program has remained consistently strong, and with the diminishing levels of appropriation through FY 1994, the DED had allocated all available funds by November 1993.

CURRENT SITUATION

The DED has adopted revised standards for the CEBA Program, primarily relating to smaller projects, in response to the Legislative mandates within HF 2180 (the IPSCO Bill). Major changes include the following:

- All applicants must now provide starting wages of at least 85.0% of the county average wage or \$9.00 per hour, whichever is less.
- No project can receive more than \$100,000 unless over half of the employees earn more than 85.0% of the county average wage.
- If the project is a business start-up the average wage must be at least 75.0% of the county average wage.
- Projects can only receive an amount greater than \$500,000 if, in addition to the normal criteria, the company meets the following additional criteria:
 - The company is not simply moving from one part of the State to another.
 - The company pays at least 80.0% of the cost of medical and dental insurance.
 - The company pays a production wage of \$11.00 per hour or 130.0% of the county average wage, whichever is higher.
- The company must be a good corporate citizen. This means that if the company has a consistent pattern of violation of Iowa law, it will be ineligible for the Program.

The following is a summary of the CEBA Program from May 1986 through June 1994.

- Awarded a total of \$55.8 million to 398 applicants. This included:
 - 259 existing lowa businesses.
 - 74 entrepreneurs starting new businesses in Iowa.
 - 65 businesses relocating into Iowa or expanding out-of-state operations in Iowa.

The number of awards given by size of community were:

- 221 awards totaling \$24.4 million to businesses in communities with a population of less than 10,000.
- 177 awards totaling \$31.4 million to businesses in communities with a population greater than 10,000.
- The 398 businesses pledged to create 21,793 jobs and to retain 12,026 jobs.
- The average cost per job pledged was \$1,651.

- The CEBA funding leveraged \$1.7 billion in other funds for the projects.
- The projects attained an average wage rate of \$9.13 per hour for jobs pledged.
- The projects that have reached the contracted job achievement date have created or retained 22,557 of 23,242 pledged jobs at an actual cost of \$1,559 per job.

Attachments 1 - 7 provide fiscal year information for FY 1987 - FY 1993. Attachment 8 provides additional summary information from May 1986, through June 1994. A table showing FY 1994 alone is not available at this time, but will be included in the FY 1994 Annual Report for the Program. Attachment 9 provides a map showing the distribution of the CEBA awards by county since the Program began.

According to the DED, some applicants have been rejected because of the new rules that would have been funded in prior years. In an example, while the overall average wage for a project met the criteria, the rule that 50.0% of the jobs being supported be above the wage standard established was not met and the company was referred to another program.

BUDGET IMPACT

Of the \$5.0 million allocated to the CEBA Program for FY 1995, the DED has \$3.1 million remaining for the balance of FY 1995. The balance includes over \$100,000 in loan repayments already received during FY 1995. If the rate and quality of applications continues, the DED again expects to obligate all available funds prior to the end of the fiscal year. A decision has not yet been made in regard to asking for a supplemental appropriation for FY 1995.

It is likely that the request for funding for FY 1996 will be equal to or above the \$7.2 million requested for FY 1995.

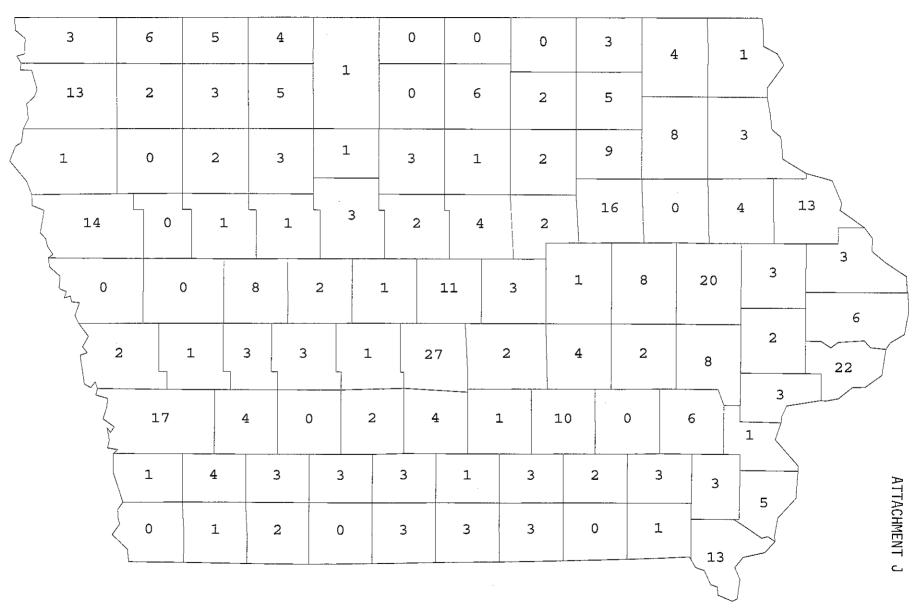
