EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

HOUSE FILE 2167

DISASTER INDIVIDUAL ASSISTANCE AND CASE ADVOCACY GRANTS BILL

SIGNIFICANT CODE CHANGES

Authorizes the Department of Homeland Security and Emergency Management to implement an ongoing contract with local administrative entities for the Disaster Aid Individual Assistance Grant Program and Disaster Case Advocacy Program. The Bill defines “local administrative entity” as a countywide provider, or a provider of a statewide program with local offices throughout the State, contracted for the administration of the Disaster Aid Individual Assistance Grant Program and the Disaster Case Advocacy Program.

Increases the Disaster Aid Individual Assistance Grant limit from \$5,000 to \$7,000 per household.
