VETERAN SERVICE OFFICER TRAINING, APPROPRIATIONS BILL

FUNDING SUMMARY

Transfers \$300,000 from the lottery moneys received by the Veterans Trust Fund for the County Commission of Veteran Affairs Training Program.

Page 1, Line 7

DETAIL: Iowa Code section [99G.39](#) allocates \$2.5 million annually in lottery proceeds to the Veterans Trust Fund.

Allocates \$3,000 to each county from the County Commission of Veterans Affairs Training Program to be used for national training and related expenses.

Page 1, Line 16

SIGNIFICANT CODE CHANGES

Specifies that the moneys transferred to the County Commission of Veterans Affairs Training Program must be used for national training and related expenses and makes inapplicable the requirements under Iowa Code section [35A.13\(5\)](#) regarding the use of moneys transferred from the Lottery Fund to the Veterans Trust Fund.
