VETERAN SERVICE OFFICER TRAINING, APPROPRIATIONS BILL

Transfers \$300,000 from the lottery moneys received by the Veterans Trust Fund for the County Commission of Veteran Affairs Training Program.

Page 2, Line 7

Allocates \$3,000 to each County Commission of Veterans Affairs to be used for national training and related expenses of county veteran service officers.

Page 2, Line 16

## SIGNIFICANT CODE CHANGES

Specifies that the moneys transferred to the County Commission of Veterans Affairs Training Program must be used for national training and related expenses and makes inapplicable the requirements under Iowa Code section 35A.13(5) regarding the use of moneys transferred from the Lottery Fund to the Veterans Trust Fund for this purpose.

CODE: Transfers \$300,000 from the lottery moneys received by the Veterans Trust Fund for the County Commission of Veteran Affairs Training Program.

DETAIL: Iowa Code section <u>99G.39</u> allocates \$2,500,000 annually in lottery proceeds to the Veterans Trust Fund.

CODE: Allocates \$3,000 to each County Commission of Veterans Affairs for the moneys transferred from the Veterans Trust Fund or to each county sharing services of an executive director or administrator under lowa Code chapter 28E to be used for national training and related expenses of county veteran service officers and staff.
