The board shall also make recommendations concerning the use of federal funds by the department of workforce development; develop and coordinate strategies for technological improvements to facilitate access to, and improve the quality of, the state's workforce development services; and make recommendations to the Governor regarding certification of local workforce development boards and the designation of local workforce development areas.
