

Iowa Child Care Providers

Three types of child care providers are regulated in Iowa: licensed centers, child development homes, and child care homes (homes serving more than five children are required to register). The Iowa Department of Human Services (DHS) performs background checks, minimum health and safety training, and completes annual monitoring visits to all child development homes.

Ratio of Children Under Age Five Per Child Care Provider




Child Care Provider Capacity Per Child Under Age Five



Quality Rating System (QRS)
Percentage of Providers by Rating



- QRS 1: Meets standard licensing or regulatory requirements.
- QRS 2: Meets a set of specific criteria including participation in food programs, ChildNet, certifications and training for staff.
- QRS 3-5: Based on a point system by category. Level 5 requires a minimum number of points as well as an Environment Rating Score (ERS) by an Iowa State University assessor.
