

Women Currently Serving in State Legislatures

- First female minority elected was Willie Stevenson Glanton (D), Polk County elected to serve the 61st G.A. (1961-1963).
- Representative Linda Upmeyer (R), Cerro Gordo County, was the first female Speaker of the House, taking oath in 2016.
