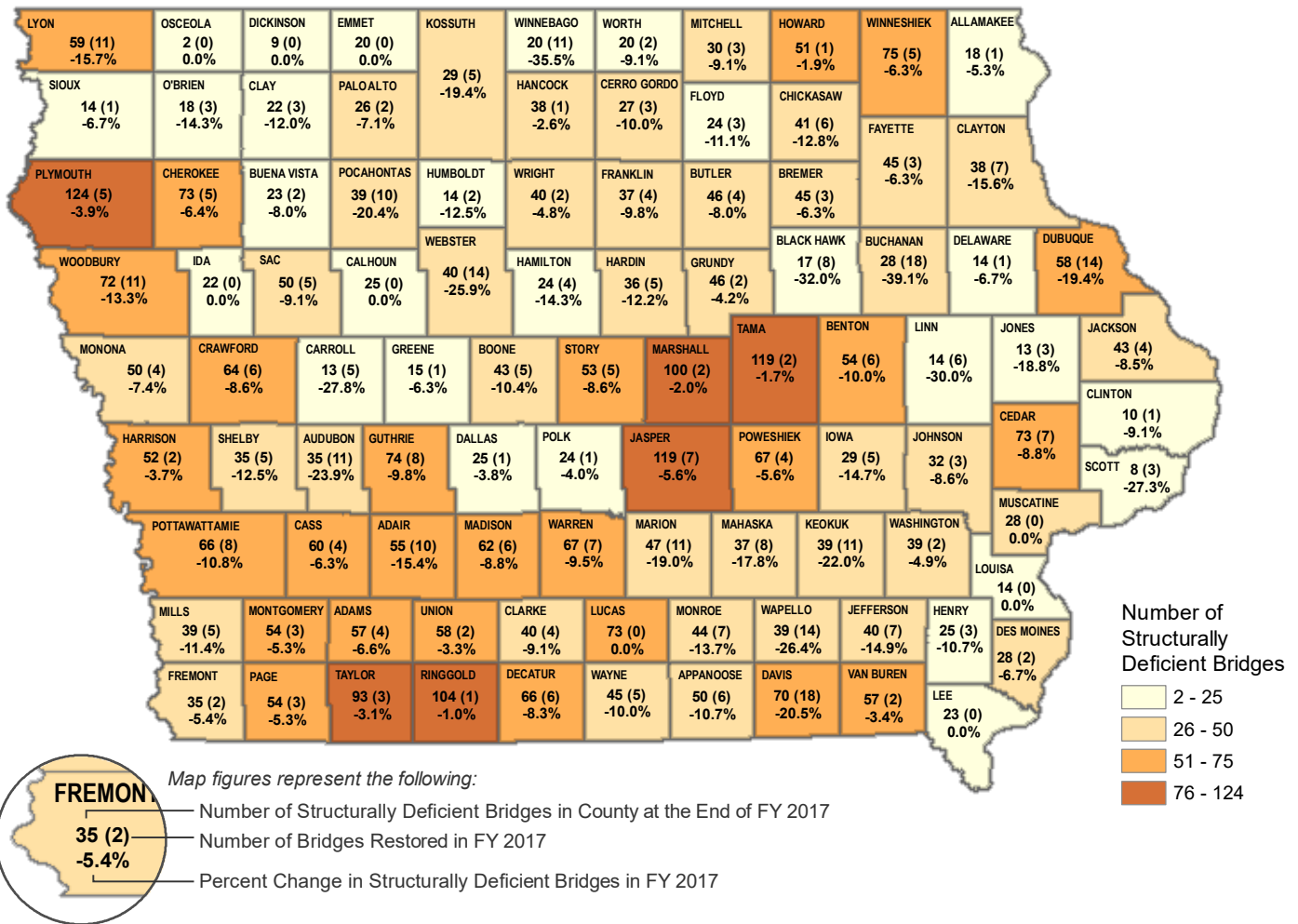


County-Owned Structurally Deficient Bridges – FY 2017



Top Five Counties with New Structurally Deficient Bridges as a Percentage of Total Structurally Deficient Bridges in FY 2017:

1. Jackson - 40.4%
2. Dubuque - 31.9%
2. Chickasaw - 31.9%
4. Kossuth - 30.6%
5. Calhoun - 28.0%

Note: A bridge is structurally deficient if there is significant deterioration of the bridge deck, supports, or other major components. Bridges that are structurally deficient are restricted to carrying lower weight vehicles or closed if they are found to be unsafe.
