
State Aviation Program: Airport Improvement Program — FY 2018


The Iowa Department of Transportation (DOT) administers the State Aviation Program. The Program provides funds to Iowa general aviation and commercial service airports in the form of grants for the Airport Improvement Program (AIP) and vertical infrastructure. The AIP provides grants for aviation safety, planning, and development. The Program is primarily funded by the State Aviation Fund, which collects fees from aircraft registration, aviation gas excise taxes and jet fuel excise taxes.

In FY 2018, the DOT allocated \$500,000 to aviation safety and \$3.3 million to planning and development. Included in the total amount is \$2.9 million for Airport Development Project grants.
