147.47 Special conditions.

A board shall have power to provide by rule that no reciprocal relation shall be entered into by the department with any state with reference to licenses to practice the profession for which the board conducts examinations, unless every person licensed in another state when applying for a license to practice in this state shall comply with one or both of the following conditions:

- 1. Furnish satisfactory proof to the department that the person has been actively engaged in the practice of the profession for a certain period of years to be fixed by the board.
- 2. Pass a practical examination in the practice of the person's particular profession as prescribed by the board.
