15.113 Economic development assistance report.

In order for the general assembly and the governor to have accurate and complete information regarding expenditures for economic development and job training incentives and to respond to the job training needs of Iowa workers, the department shall provide to the legislative services agency and the governor by January 15 of each year data on all assistance or benefits provided under the community economic betterment program, the high quality job creation program, and the Iowa industrial new jobs training Act during the previous calendar year. The department shall meet with the legislative services agency and the governor prior to submitting the data to assure that its form and specificity are sufficient to provide accurate and complete information to the general assembly and the governor. The department shall also contact other state agencies providing financial assistance to Iowa businesses and, to the extent practical, coordinate the submission of the data to the legislative services agency and the governor.
