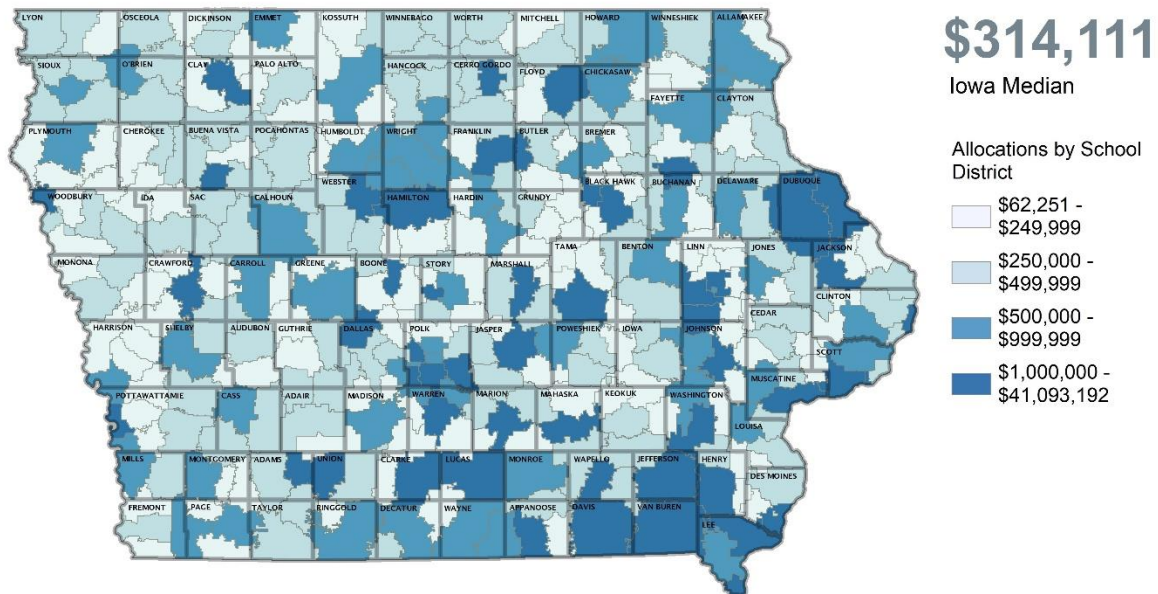

ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOL EMERGENCY RELIEF (ESSER) FUND II ALLOCATIONS — COVID-19

Department of Education. The Department of Education received \$344.9 million in federal funds for school districts to address costs incurred due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Of the total amount, \$310.4 million (90.0%) will be allocated to school districts based on each district's eligibility for Title I, [Part A](#) funding. The remaining \$34.5 million (10.0%) will be used for State-level educational efforts to address issues caused by the pandemic. The funds are available for obligation through September 30, 2023.

The following map shows allocations by school district. The minimum allocation is approximately \$62,000 and the maximum allocation is approximately \$41.1 million.
