FFY 2023 Annual Report of Enforcement Activities

As required by Iowa Code 80.5(11), this report is intended to outline the nature and scope of enforcement activities by the Department of Transportation's Motor Vehicle Enforcement (MVE) Bureau/Iowa State Patrol's Commercial Motor Vehicle Unit (CMVU)¹ during FFY 2023.

¹ As a result of SF 513, the Department of Transportation (DOT)'s Motor Vehicle Enforcement Bureau was transferred to the Department of Public Safety (DPS) effective July 1, 2023, where they are now a specialized unit within the Iowa State Patrol known as the Commercial Motor Vehicle Unit. Enforcement activities documented between October 1, 2022 and June 30, 2023 were as MVE officers at DOT, and activities documented between July 1, 2023 and September 30, 2023 were as CMVU troopers within the Iowa State Patrol.
