

State Park, Forest, and Recreation Area Visits — CY 2019


Numerous outdoor opportunities exist in Iowa. The Department of Natural Resources' <u>Guide to Iowa State Parks</u> includes information on the following outdoor attractions:

- State parks and recreation areas, which offer camping, hiking, hunting, fishing, and other outdoor activities.
- · State forests, which offer hiking, hunting, and camping.
- <u>State preserves</u>, which have fewer recreational activities but feature unique biological natural resources, geological sites, archaeological finds, historical areas, or scenic views.
- Distinctive facilities such as the <u>Springbrook Conservation</u> <u>Education Center</u>* and <u>Honey Creek Resort</u>, which provide educational and recreational outdoor activities for groups and classrooms.
