# **Vocational-Technical Tuition Grant**

## **Eligibility**

To be eligible for the Iowa Vocational-Technical Tuition Grant, an applicant must be an Iowa resident who establishes financial need and is enrolled at an Iowa community college.

A student may receive a grant for not more than the equivalent of two full years of study. However, if a student resumes study after at least a two-year absence, the student may again be eligible for two full years of study but cannot receive assistance for courses for which credit was previously received.

#### **Awards**

The maximum annual award is the lesser of \$1,200 per year or the amount of the student's financial need. Part-time students may be eligible for adjusted amounts.

### **Funding**

The Vocational-Technical Tuition Grant is funded through a General Fund standing appropriation in statute. However, in practice, the General Assembly frequently amends the statute to increase or decrease funding in any given year.
