Capitol Dome Repairs — SBRF

Purpose

This appropriation fully funds the estimated cost to repair the Capitol dome. The Department of Administrative Services selected OPN Architects to study problems within the Capitol dome late in November 2015. The architects issued a report that reviewed a history of repairs to the dome and assessed the condition of the dome. A review of the dome discovered ongoing maintenance issues including water leakage, humidity, and temperature regulation issues. The report also identified deterioration of windows and external surfaces including sandstone. As of October 2017, the project is ahead of schedule and expected to be complete by June 2018.

Funding

This project received a single appropriation from the State Bond Repayment Fund of \$9.99 million in FY 2017.
