Mount Pleasant/Fairfield Facility — Primary Road Fund

Purpose and History

The Department of Transportation (DOT) manages nearly 150 maintenance garages, construction facilities, materials labs, and district offices. The DOT generally receives an appropriation for one major renovation or replacement project per fiscal year. The following is a list of previous projects approved by the General Assembly:

- FY 2008 Clarinda (\$2.3 million)
- FY 2009 Waukon (\$2.5 million)
- FY 2010 Rockwell City (\$3.0 million)
- FY 2012 Swea City (\$2.1 million)
- FY 2013 New Hampton (\$5.2 million)
- FY 2014 Mason City Combined Facility (\$6.5 million)
- FY 2015 Des Moines North Garage (\$6.4 million)
- FY 2016 Muscatine/Wapello Combined Facility (\$5.4 million)
- FY 2016 Ames Administration Building (\$2.0 million)

The maintenance operations in Mount Pleasant and Fairfield are being combined into the construction of a new maintenance garage in Fairfield.

State Funding

The appropriation for these capital projects is included in the Transportation Appropriations Act under the purview of the Transportation, Infrastructure, and Capitals Appropriations Subcommittee. In FY 2017, \$4.9 million was appropriated from the Primary Road Fund.
