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# **Attendance Center/Data Systems**

#### Overview

The Education Reform Act (HF 215) enacted during the 2013 Legislative Session required the Department of Education (DE) to develop criteria and a process for establishing an attendance center ranking and performance index. The DE is to develop an overall school performance grade and report card for each attendance center. The information and rankings for each attendance center must be posted on the Department's website. The criteria considered must include but is not limited to the following: student academic growth, parent involvement, student attendance, employee turnover, and community activities and involvement. In 2019, the DE combined federal reporting requirements under the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) and State reporting requirements onto the lowa School Performance Profiles site.

The DE may also use the appropriation for general website and data system support and maintenance.

## **Funding**

The first year of funding was FY 2015, when the Department received a General Fund appropriation of \$500,000 and was authorized 2.0 full-time equivalent (FTE) positions for the attendance center performance rankings and general website and data system support. Since FY 2016, the Department has received approximately \$250,000 annually.
