Antitrust Fund

Purpose

The Attorney General is charged with the enforcement of Iowa Code chapters <u>551</u> and <u>553</u>, Iowa's antitrust laws. The Office of the Attorney General may institute civil or criminal proceedings to enforce these laws. The Antitrust Fund is created in Iowa Code section <u>553.19</u> under the administration of the Attorney General. This restricted Fund is used for the investigation and prosecution of anticompetitive practices.

Funding

Receipts to the Fund include amounts received from lowa or federal civil antitrust judgments or settlements that are based on damages sustained by the State, civil penalties, attorney fees, costs, amounts that are specifically directed to the Fund by the judgment or settlement, and amounts that are designated by the settlement or judgment for use by the Attorney General for antitrust enforcement or education. The lowa Code provides a standing limited appropriation of \$500,000 annually from the Fund to the Office of the Attorney General for the enforcement of lowa and federal antitrust laws. The year-end balance carries forward to the next fiscal year. Interest earnings remain in the Fund. The majority of expenditures consist of reimbursements to the Office of the Attorney General for enforcement of lowa and federal antitrust laws.
