Routine Maintenance Fund — RIIF

Purpose and History

This is a standing appropriation from the Rebuild Iowa Infrastructure Fund (RIIF) that was established by the 2018 General Assembly to fund routine maintenance projects for State buildings and facilities, excluding buildings and facilities under the control of the Board of Regents, Department of Transportation, Department of Natural Resources, and Department of Public Defense. Iowa Code section <u>8A.330</u> defines routine maintenance as the "regular upkeep of physical properties and recurring, preventative, and ongoing maintenance necessary to delay or prevent the failure of physical properties." Examples of routine maintenance include but are not limited to the following:

- Painting
- Sealing
- Parking lot and sidewalk repairs
- Routine tuck-pointing

Funding

This is a standing appropriation of \$2.0 million.
