



Iowa Law Enforcement Academy Gifts and Donations Fund

Purpose and History

Any gifts or donations made to the Iowa Law Enforcement Academy (ILEA) are deposited in the Gifts and Donations Fund. Sometimes the gift or donation is earmarked for a special use, for example if a class donates money to buy a piece of equipment for training. Within the Gifts and Donations Fund, there is a separate account entitled McCartney Bequest. The award has been given on behalf of former Floyd County Sheriff R. C. McCartney since 1969. A \$50 stipend is awarded five to six times a year for the most conscientious officer in each Basic recruit class.

Funding

Money is deposited in the Fund as it is received.
