Court Technology and Modernization Fund

Purpose and History

The Court Technology and Modernization Fund is administered by the Supreme Court and is used to enhance the ability of the Judicial Branch to process cases more quickly and efficiently; to electronically transmit information to state government, local governments, law enforcement agencies, and the public; and to improve public access to the court system.

Funding

Of the fines and fees collected by the Judicial Branch, prior to being deposited in the General Fund, the State Court Administrator is permitted to allocate \$1.0 million to the Court Technology and Modernization Fund. In addition, of the money collected from the sex offender civil penalty, 10.0% of the penalty is to be deposited in the Court Technology and Modernization Fund.

The State Court Administrator's Office is responsible for submitting a report to the General Assembly in January of each year.
