# Special Education Services for Children from Birth to Age Three

### **Purpose**

The Special Education Services for Children from Birth to Age Three appropriation supplements federal funding under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) for the state's early childhood special education services. (NOTE: In the budget tracking system the title of this appropriation is Special Education Services Birth to Three.)

## **Federal Funding Requirements**

The General Assembly has appropriated funds for this purpose since FY 2008 with a General Fund appropriation and currently appropriates \$1,721,400. The IDEA does not require states to provide matching appropriations to draw federal funds. However, once a state appropriates special education funding, the federal government requires the level of state funding to be maintained from year to year. Any reduction in the state appropriation may result in the loss of all IDEA funding for early childhood special education.

The federal grant specifies an allocation to be used for administrative costs by the Department of Education.
