



Inmate Tort Claims Fund

Purpose

lowa Code section <u>904.311</u> creates an Inmate Tort Claim Fund under the control of the Director of the <u>Department of Corrections</u> (DOC). The Fund is used to reimburse offenders in the Institutions for the damage or loss of property caused by the DOC. A single loss may be no more than \$100. An example of an eligible claim for reimbursement is the replacement of an offender's radio damaged by staff during a cell extraction. Claims for damages in excess of \$100 are submitted to the State Appeal Board under lowa Code chapter <u>669</u>.

Receipts and Expenditures

Total resources in the Fund averaged approximately \$5,000 over the last four fiscal years (FY 2011 through FY 2014). Average annual expenditures were approximately \$2,700 over the same reporting period. The year-end Fund balance carries forward to the next fiscal year. The correctional institutions transfer General Fund money as needed to the Fund to meet expenses.
