Purpose

The Larned A. Waterman Iowa Nonprofit Resource Center strives to help Iowa's charitable nonprofit organizations become more effective in building their communities by offering useful information and prompt assistance from across the University of Iowa. Training opportunities offered by the Center are intended to assist nonprofit organizations in implementing the Iowa Principles and Practices for Charitable Nonprofit Excellence (P&P).

The P&P sessions are designed to help nonprofit managers, staff, board members, volunteers, and others develop skills that will benefit their nonprofit organizations. The training sessions are scheduled periodically throughout lowa. Completion of a P&P training session is one of three ways a nonprofit organization may be listed on the lowa Register of Accountability.

The lowa Principles and Practices are based on the Minnesota Principles and Practices of Nonprofit Excellence sponsored by the Minnesota Council of Nonprofits. They were developed along with the Register of Accountability at the recommendation of the Governor's Task Force on the Role of Charitable Nonprofit Organizations in Iowa in 2005.

Funding

State support for the Center began in FY 2008 with a General Fund appropriation of \$200,000, and has ranged between a low of \$163,000 (FY 2012 through FY 2017) and a high of \$202,000 (FY 2009).
