# **University of Iowa - Primary Health Care Initiative**

#### **Purpose**

The Primary Health Care Initiative funds four programs that form an essential foundation for the primary care workforce efforts of the University of Iowa Health Sciences Center. The programs are:

- The Rural Physician Support Program.
- The Iowa Health Professions Inventory.
- The Department of Family Medicine Predoctoral Teaching Program.
- The Regional Medical Education Center Grant Program.

The Initiative supports operational programs that educate and train future health professionals and helps efforts to recruit, place, retain, and track today's workforce.

## **Funding**

Beginning with a \$330,000 General Fund appropriation in FY 1994, state funding for the Initiative has ranged between a low of \$630,000 (FY 1995) and a high of \$917,000 (FY 2001).
