Purpose and History

The <u>Nutrient Reduction Strategy</u> report was introduced in November 2012, as a collaborative effort by the Department of Agriculture and Land Stewardship (DALS), the Department of Natural Resources (DNR), and Iowa State University (ISU) to assess and reduce nutrients that flow into Iowa waters. The Water Quality Initiative Program was created in SF 435 (FY 2014 Agriculture and Natural Resources Appropriations Act) with the goal to provide funding for watershed practices in high-priority watersheds as designated by the <u>Water Resources Coordinating Council</u> (WRCC). Senate File 435 appropriated funds to ISU for the creation of the ISU Nutrient Research Center. The Center received appropriations of \$1.5 million for FY 2014 and \$1.3 million for FY 2015.
