



## University of Iowa – Entrepreneur and Economic Growth -Skilled Worker and Job Creation Fund

## **Purpose and History**

The <u>Skilled Worker and Job Creation Fund</u> (SWJCF) appropriation to the <u>University of Iowa</u> began with FY 2014 and is for the Entrepreneurship and Economic Growth Initiative. The appropriation is to be used to expand public/private partnerships and programing through the <u>Pappajohn Entrepreneurial Center</u>.

## Funding – Other Sources of Revenue

While the first appropriation was for FY 2014 and was made in the Education Appropriations Act (<u>HF 604 - 2013 Iowa Acts, chapter 141, section 54</u>) the appropriation has been made from the Skilled Worker and Job Creation Fund in the Economic Development Appropriations Act after the first year, as of FY 2016. In addition, these programs operate with various levels of support from sales and services, interest, and other miscellaneous sources of income.
