# Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM)

## **Purpose and History**

The <u>Iowa Economic Development Authority</u> (IEDA) Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) budget unit is to provide internships for students that are to lead to a permanent position studying in the fields of STEM, with innovative Iowa employers as provided in Iowa Code section <u>15.411(3)(c)</u>. The business may receive an amount of one dollar for every dollar paid by the employer to the intern, not to exceed \$5,000 per internship.

The program was established during the 2014 Legislative Session in HF 2460 (Economic Development Appropriations Act).

The IEDA may use no more than 3.0% of appropriated funds for administration costs.

The appropriated funds remaining unencumbered or unobligated at the end of a fiscal year are not to revert and are to remain available for expenditure for STEM purposes in subsequent fiscal years.

# Funding - State General Fund

The Economic Development Authority STEM appropriation of \$1.0 million was made during the 2014 Legislative Session in HF 2460.
