Groundwater Protection Fund -- Landfill Alternatives

Purpose and History

The 1987 General Assembly created the Groundwater Protection Fund (GWPF) for the purpose of protecting state groundwater. The GWPF is administered by the Department of Natural Resources (DNR). Since 2000, the General Assembly has appropriated from the GWPF to the DNR for administrative support of Groundwater Protection Act programs. The Landfill Alternatives appropriation supports the administration of the <u>Solid Waste Alternatives Program</u> that provides grants to local governments, public and private groups, businesses, and individuals for education, market development projects, and utilization of best practices to reduce landfilled waste.

Funding History

Since 2000, the General Assembly has appropriated a total of \$619,000 for the Landfill Alternatives.
