University of Iowa — Child Health Specialty Clinics

Purpose

The Child Health Specialty Clinics (CHSC) serve children and youth, birth through 21 years of age, who live in lowa and have a chronic condition (physical, developmental, behavioral, or emotional) or are at increased risk for a chronic condition and also have a need for special services. The Clinics facilitate the development of family-centered, community-based, coordinated systems of care. The CHSC is funded partially by the federal Title V Maternal and Child Health Block Grant, in addition to funding provided by the lowa Department of Public Health, the lowa Department of Education, the lowa Department of Human Services, and other community partners. The CHSC is administered by the Department of Pediatrics at the University of lowa.
