# **Department of Revenue — Motor Vehicle Fuel Tax**

## **Purpose and History**

The lowa Department of Revenue (IDR) administers and oversees the major sources of State and local tax revenue. The IDR is divided into six major divisions:

- Compliance Division
- Internal Services Division
- Property Tax Division
- Revenue Operations Division
- Tax Policy and Communications Division
- Technology and Information Management Division

The Department's key responsibilities include collecting revenue and supervising a variety of property tax-related functions performed by local government officials. In addition to these duties, lowa Code section 452A.57 requires the IDR and the Department of Transportation to act as administrators of funds collected from the Motor Vehicle Fuel Tax (MVFT), depending on which entity receives the initial tax payment.

#### **Funding**

The IDR receives an annual appropriation from the Motor Vehicle Fuel Tax Fund as authorized under lowa Code section 452A.77. The appropriation is used for salaries, support, maintenance, and miscellaneous purposes, as well as the administration and enforcement of the provisions of lowa Code chapter 452A and the Motor Vehicle Fuel Tax Program.
