Labor Services Division – Iowa Workforce Development

Purpose and History

The Labor Services Division of the Iowa Workforce Development is responsible for enforcing safety in the workplace; providing consultation to employers on occupational safety health compliance; conducting certain equipment inspections; maintaining statistical information illness and injuries in the workplace; and enforcing wage, labor, and child labor laws. The Division is headed by the Labor Commissioner. The Commissioner is appointed by the Governor and confirmed by the Senate for a six-year term.

Funding

The Labor Services Division receives a State General Fund appropriation. State funds represent approximately 50.0% of the total resources available to the Division. The Labor Services Division also uses a portion of State funds to match and obtain federal funds from the Occupational Safety and Health Administration.
