

University of Iowa — Child Health Specialty Clinics

Purpose

The Child Health Specialty Clinics (CHSC) serve children and youth, birth through 21 years of age, who live in Iowa and have a chronic condition (physical, developmental, behavioral, or emotional) or are at increased risk for a chronic condition and also have a need for special services. The Clinics facilitate the development of family-centered, community-based, coordinated systems of care. The CHSC is funded partially by the federal Title V Maternal and Child Health Block Grant, in addition to funding provided by the Iowa Department of Public Health, the Iowa Department of Education, the Iowa Department of Human Services, and other community partners. The CHSC is administered by the Department of Pediatrics at the University of Iowa.
