- SCR 1 Inauguration of Governor and Lieutenant Governor, joint committee named to make arrangements. Adopted, S. J. 9; H. J. 17, 24.
- SCR 2 Code of Iowa and Session Laws to legislature and staff and to certain members of the press. Adopted, S. J. 10; H. J. 18, 24.
- SCR 3 Bills and Journals to county auditors. Adopted, S. J. 10; H. J. 18, 24.
- SCR 4 Mobile homes and parks, committee to study statutes. Introduced, S. J. 56, 57.
- SCR 5 Educational agencies, committees comprised of legislators to study needs and report to General Assembly sixty days prior to next session. Introduced, S. J. 91, 92.
- SCR 6 Compensation of chaplains, officers and employees of the Sixty-third General Assembly. Adopted, S. J. 117, 130; H. J. 133, 150.
- SCR 7 Compensation of joint legislative employees of the General Assembly. Adopted, S. J. 125, 132; H. J. 135, 150.
- SCR 8 Pioneer Lawmakers invited to joint session, April 3, 1969. Adopted, S. J. 467; H. J. 533, 614.
- SCR 9 Littering and use of hazardous chemicals and drugs, Legislative committee to study problem and make recommendations to 1970 Session. Adopted, S. J. 219, 357; H. J. 433, 541.
