



AN ACT

RELATING TO THE REQUIREMENTS FOR NATIONAL CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD CHECKS FOR CHILD CARE PROVIDERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 237A.5, subsection 2, paragraph d, subparagraph (1), Code Supplement 2009, is amended to read as follows:

(1) For a person subject to a record check, in addition to any other record check conducted pursuant to this subsection, the person's fingerprints shall be provided to the department of public safety for submission through the state criminal history repository to the United States department of justice, federal bureau of investigation for a national criminal history check. The department may adopt rules specifying criteria in the public

interest for requiring the national criminal history check shall of a person to be repeated every four years.
