AN ACT

RELATING TO SERVICE IN AN HONOR GUARD UNIT ON PUBLIC PROPERTY.


BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:


Section 1. Section 35A.12, Code 2009, is amended to read as follows:

35A.12 Military honor guard services.


An honor guard unit made up of members of a recognized military veterans organization as listed in section 35A.2 or 37.2, the Iowa national guard, the reserve forces of the United

States, the United States coast guard auxiliary, or a reserve officers training corps shall be allowed to perform any honor guard service on public property.


