House File 258

AN ACT

RELATING TO SEXUAL MISCONDUCT WITH OFFENDERS AND JUVENILES, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 709.16, Code 2015, is amended to read as follows:

709.16 Sexual misconduct with offenders and juveniles.

- 1. An Any peace officer, or an officer, employee, contractor, vendor, volunteer, or agent of the department of corrections, or an officer, employee, or agent of a judicial district department of correctional services, who engages in a sex act with an individual committed to the custody of the department of corrections or a judicial district department of correctional services commits an aggravated misdemeanor.
- 2. a. An Any peace officer, or an officer, employee, contractor, vendor, volunteer, or agent of a juvenile placement facility who engages in a sex act with a juvenile placed at such facility commits an aggravated misdemeanor.
- b. For purposes of this subsection, a "juvenile placement
 facility" means any of the following:
- (1) A child foster care facility licensed under section 237.4.
- (2) Institutions controlled by the department of human services listed in section 218.1.
- (3) Juvenile detention and juvenile shelter care homes approved under section 232.142.
- (4) Psychiatric medical institutions for children licensed under chapter 135H.
- (5) Facilities for the treatment of persons with substance-related disorders as defined in section 125.2.

3. An Any peace officer, or an officer, employee, contractor, vendor, volunteer, or agent of a county who engages in a sex act with a prisoner incarcerated in a county jail commits an aggravated misdemeanor.
