

## AN ACT

RELATING TO THE CRIMINAL OFFENSE OF THEFT IN THE THIRD DEGREE AND MAKING PENALTIES APPLICABLE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 714.2, subsection 3, Code 2020, is amended to read as follows:

3. The theft of property exceeding seven hundred fifty dollars but not exceeding one thousand five hundred dollars in value, or the theft of any property not exceeding <u>five</u> <u>seven</u> hundred fifty dollars in value by one who has before been twice

convicted of theft, is theft in the third degree. Theft in the third degree is an aggravated misdemeanor.
