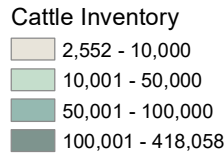

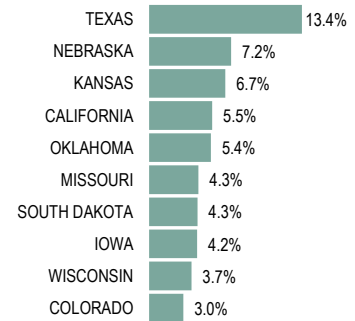

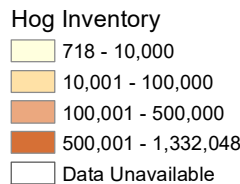
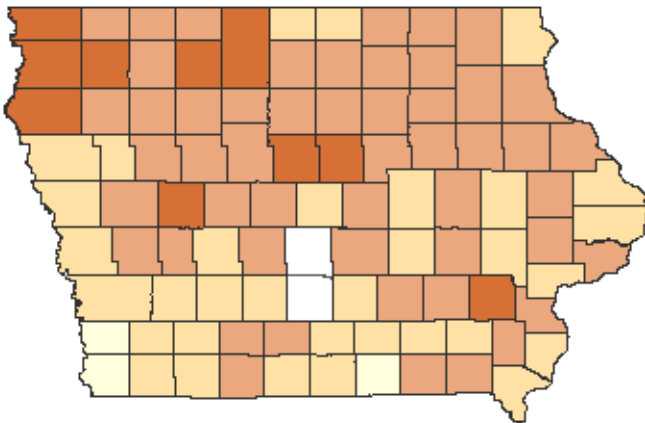
State Ranking of Percentage of U.S. Livestock Inventories — 2017

Percentage of Cattle Inventory



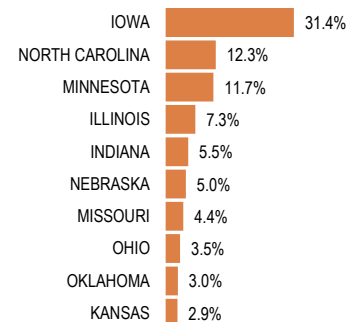

Iowa Hog Inventory — 2017



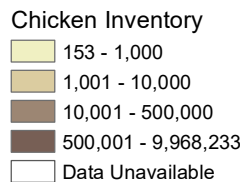
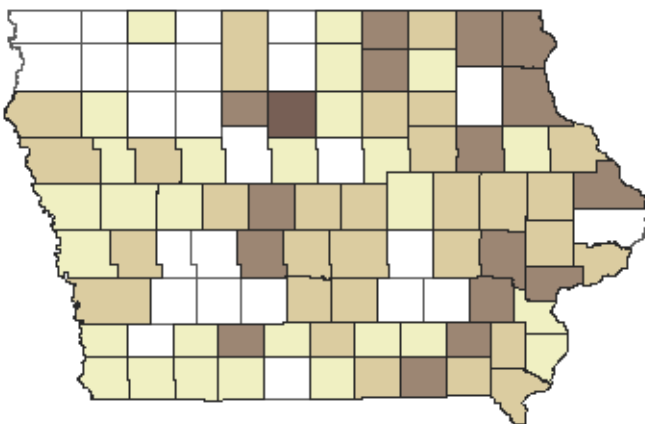

Percentage of Hog Inventory



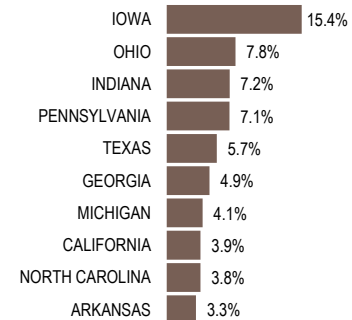

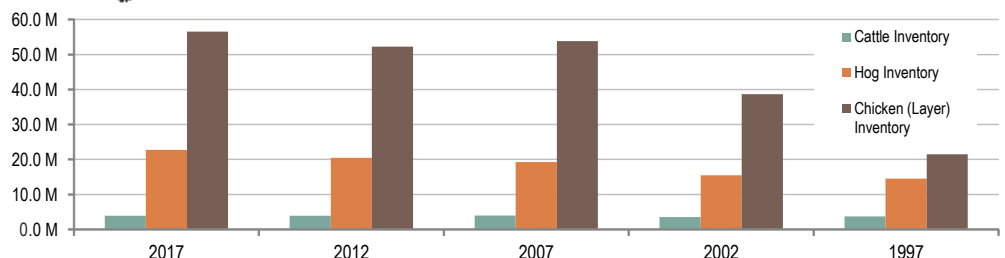
Percentage of Chicken (Layer) Inventory
