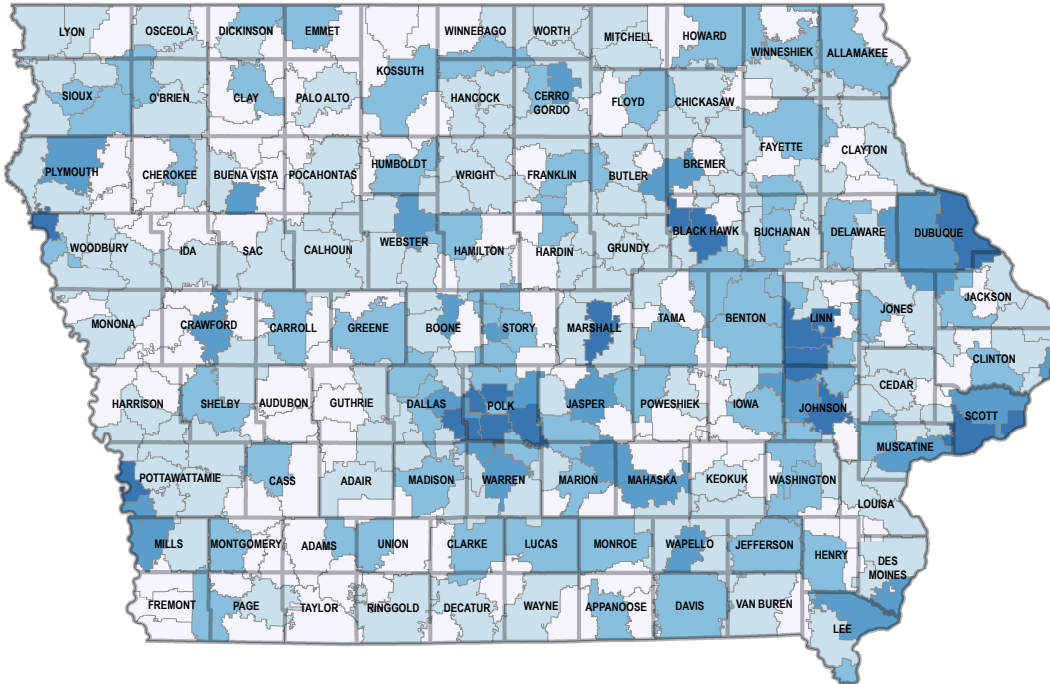


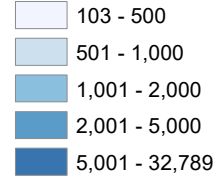

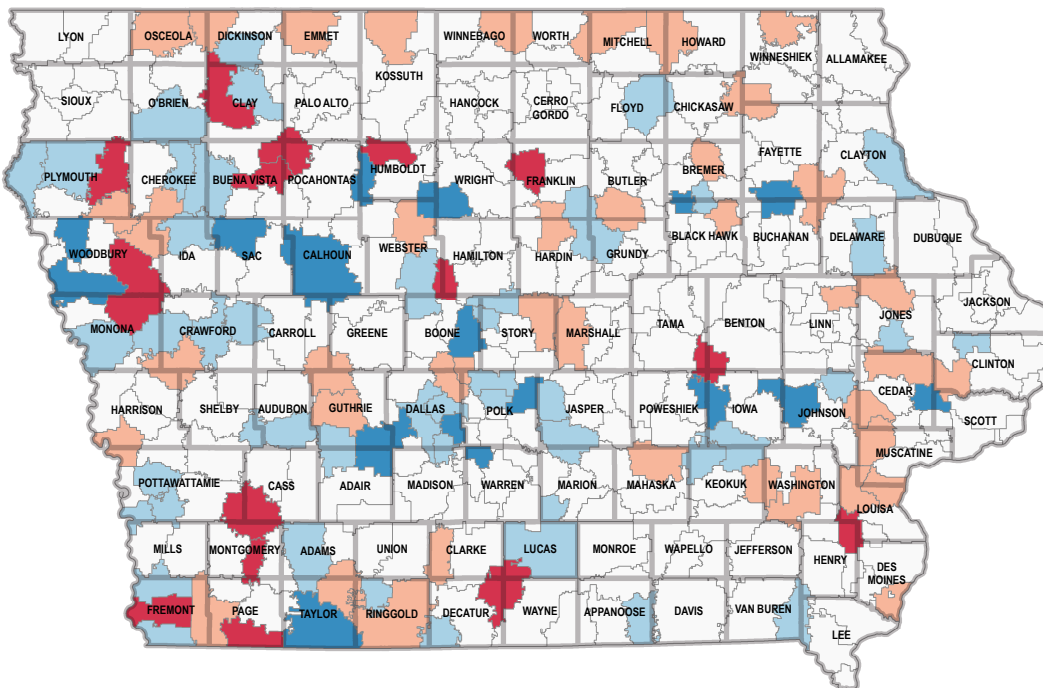

Percent Change in Certified Enrollment — Fall 2018 vs. Fall 2017

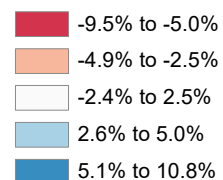
