

Statewide Voluntary Preschool Enrollment — 2019-2020 School Year with Average Weekly Hours of Instruction — 2018-2019 School Year

During the 2007 Legislative session, a statewide voluntary preschool program (SWVPP) for four-year-old children was created to be implemented through school districts. The program is administered at the State level by the State Board of Education and the Department of Education. School districts that participate must provide at least 10 hours of instruction per week. State aid funding for the program is based on the previous year's enrollment multiplied by 50.0%, and multiplied by the regular program State cost per pupil. The following maps show enrollment by district for the 2019-2020 school year, and average weekly hours of instruction for the 2018-2019 school year.
