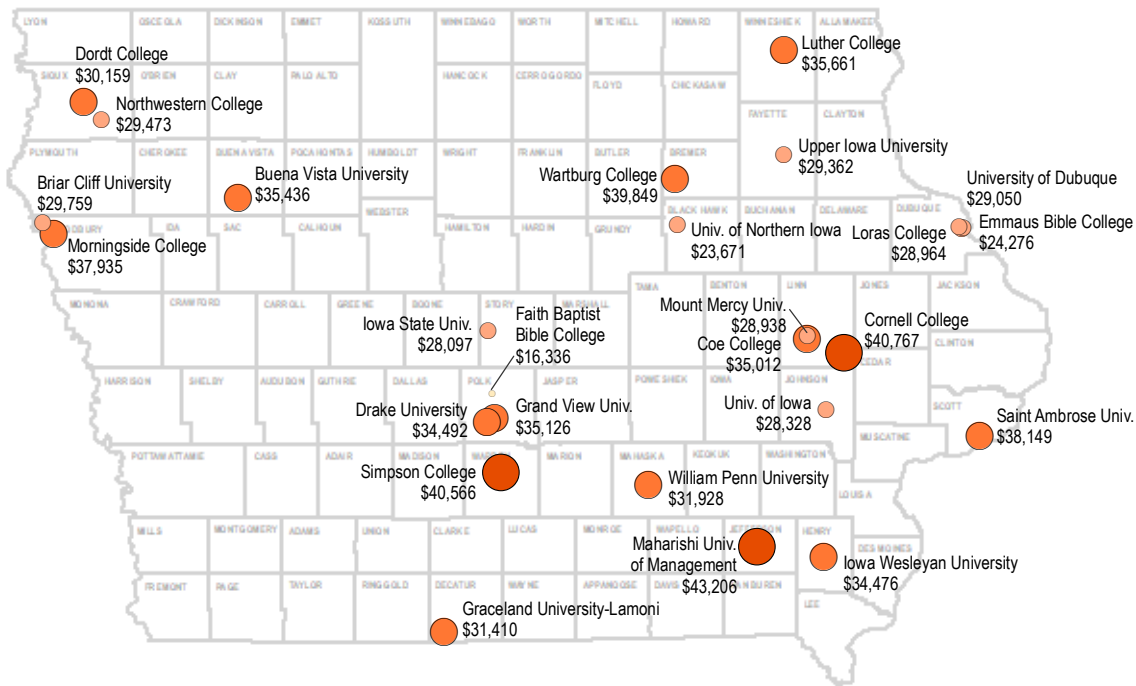


Average Debt and Yearly Expenses by Regent and Nonpublic Colleges and Universities

Percentage of Graduates with Debt

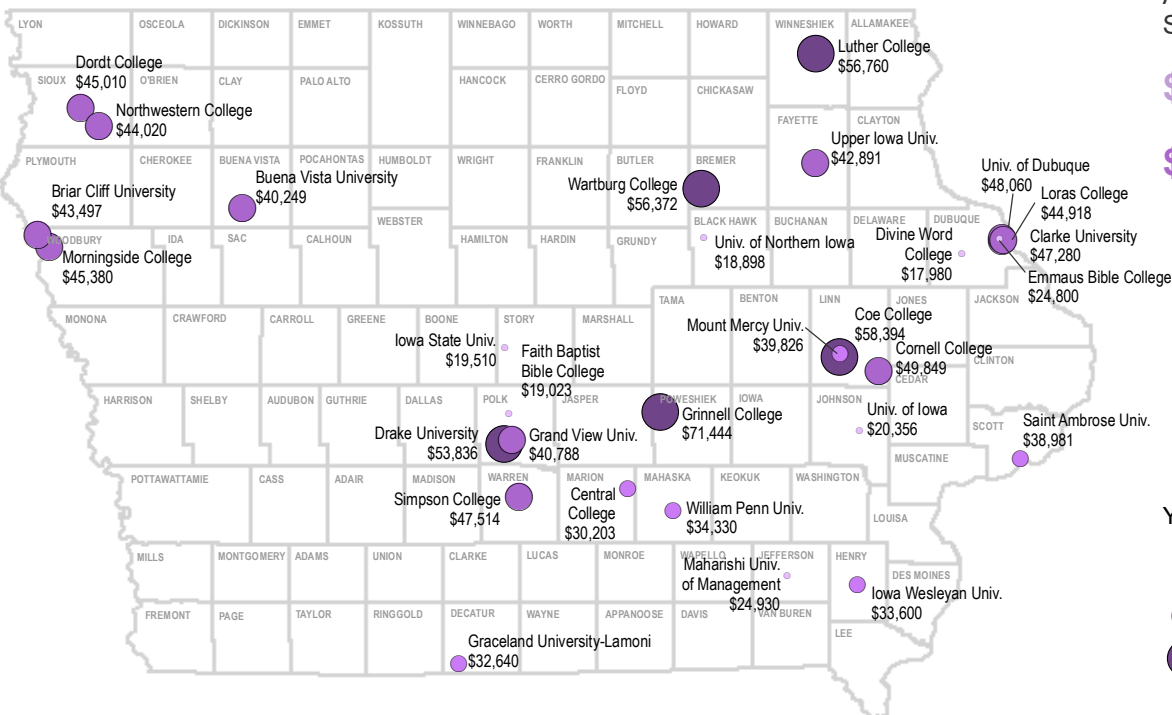
54.3% Regent Universities
