RELEASE OF SECOND PROPOSED REDISTRICTING PLAN

The Legislative Services Agency will deliver to the members of the General Assembly a second proposed congressional and legislative redistricting plan at 10:00 a.m. on October 21, 2021. The documents delivered to the members of the General Assembly will include a bill embodying the plan as well as a statistical report providing information concerning the plan, including maps of the proposed congressional and state legislative districts.

Shortly after delivery of the redistricting plan to the members of the General Assembly, the information submitted will be made available to the public through the Internet on the Iowa Redistricting 2021 link accessible from the Iowa General Assembly's home page. https://www.legis.iowa.gov/legislators/redistricting

Information on the website will include a copy of the bill and the statistical report delivered to the General Assembly as well as maps of the proposed congressional, state Senate, and state Representative districts, to include individual state legislative district maps. In addition, the boundaries of the congressional and legislative districts will be available for download in an ESRI shapefile format, a Census block equivalency file, a KML file, and as a Geographic Information System (GIS) web service.
