Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly Division. of the State of Iowa, The State is hereby divided into twelve Districts for Judicial purposes.

trict.

for four years until their successors are elected and qualified. The District Courts shall be held in the SEC. 19. Courts in 10th 11th and 12th several counties of the Tenth and Eleventh Judicial Districts. Districts, as heretofore provided by law, and have full jurisdiction in all counties composing said District prior to the passage of this Act, until the first Monday in January, 1865, after which the jurisdiction of the Judges of the said tenth, eleventh and twelfth Judicial Districts shall extend to the said Districts as herein provided.

All Acts and parts of Acts inconsistent with this Act

are hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 99.

COUNTY COURTS.

AN ACT to change the time of holding County Courts in April and August.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly Time of hold-of the State of Iowa, That Section 261, of the Revision ing. of 1860 be amended so as to read as follows: County Court shall be considered in law as always open, but for the transaction of business requiring notice, the Judge shall hold regular sessions on the first Monday of each month.
