CHAPTER 29.

RELIEF OF CERTAIN RESIDENTS OF HARRISON COUNTY.

AN ACT to secure to certain persons, residents of Harrison county, their homes, at the price of \$1.25 per acre, of lands known as the excess 500,000 acre grant.

Section 1. Sec. 3. All Acts, or parts of Acts, inconsistent with this Act, are hereby repealed. Approved March 15th, 1866.
