## CHAPTER 87.

## RELATING TO TAXES FOR BRIDGES.

AN ACT to amend Sections 710 and 312 of the Revision of 1860.

Former act amended.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa, That subdivision four of Section 710 of the Revision of 1860, is hereby amended so as to read as follows, to-wit: For making and repairing bridges not more than three mills on the dollar.

Words stricken out. \$5,000 inserted.

SEC. 2. Subdivision 23 of Section 312 is hereby amended by striking out the words "two thousand dollars" and inserting in place thereof the words Five thousand dollars, provided that this act shall not authorize the purchase of real estate exceeding two thousand dollars in value without the previous approbation of the legal voters of the county, as provided in the provision hereby amended.

SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect and be in force Publication. from and after its publication in the Iowa State Register, and the Iowa Homestead.
