

CHAPTER 36.

STATE UNIVERSITY.

MARCH 24. AN ACT Appropriating Funds to the State University of Iowa.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa,* That there be appropriated out of any moneys in the State treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars, for the use and support of the State University for the next two years.

SEC. 2. Of the amount so appropriated, one-half shall be paid over annually to the treasurer of the Board of Trustees of the University upon an order from the executive committee thereof, countersigned by the secretary of the board, and addressed to the State Treasurer.

SEC. 3. This act to take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the State Register and Iowa City Republican.

CHAPTER 37.

DISTRICT-TOWNSHIP AND INDEPENDENT DISTRICT OF TOLEDO.

MARCH 25. AN ACT to Legalize the Tax-Levy of the District-Township of Toledo, and the Independent District of Toledo, in the Township of Toledo, in Tama County, for the year 1869.

Preamble. WHEREAS, The electors of the district-township of Toledo did, at their annual March meeting in 1869, vote a tax of ten mills on the dollar, on the taxable property of the district-township, for school-house purposes; and

WHEREAS, The board of directors of the district-township of Toledo did, on the fifteenth day of March of said year, apportion the said tax among the sub-districts as follows: on sub-district number one, ten mills on the dollar; on sub-district number two, eight mills on the dollar; on sub-district number three, two mills on the
