

CHAPTER 182.

THE PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE CONSTITUTION.

AN ACT to Provide for due Reference and Publication of Proposals to amend the Constitution of the State of Iowa. APRIL 16.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa,* That the resolutions proposing to amend the constitution of the State of Iowa, which have been passed at the present session of the General Assembly of the said State, are hereby referred to the legislature to be chosen at the next general election.

Proposed amendments referred to next G. A.

SEC. 2. The Secretary shall cause the same to be published, for three months previous to the time of the next general election of members of the legislature, in one newspaper in each congressional district.

Sec'y of State to publish.

CHAPTER 183.

RE-SURVEY OF LANDS.

AN ACT to Define the Manner in which the Re-survey of Lands shall be made. APRIL 16.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa,* That in the re-survey and subdivisions of lands by county surveyors, their deputies, or other person[s], the rules prescribed by acts of Congress and the instruction[s] of the Secretary of the Interior, shall be in all respects followed.

Rules to be followed.

SEC. 2. Said rules and regulations shall be published in pamphlet form under direction of the Register of the State Land Office, and one copy furnished for the use of each county surveyor.

Rules and regulations to be published by Register of S. L. O., and furnished to co. surveyors.
