suit in any court having jurisdiction of the same, the value of such property which such city or town authorities may have caused to

be destroyed to prevent the spread of such conflagration.

SEC. 2. That upon the payment of the amount to which said Assignment party is entitled, by such city or town, as provided in section 1 of policy. this act, the party so paid, as aforesaid, shall assign and set over to said city or town all his right, title, and interest in and to any insurance policy, or any claim he may have against any insurance company, for said property so destroyed or any part thereof.

SEC. 3. This act being deemed of immediate importance shall take effect from and after its publication in the Daily Iowa State Leader and Des Moines Journal, newspapers published in Des

Moines, Iowa.

THRESHING-MACHINES.

AN ACT to Amend Section 4064 of the Code [Title XXIV., Chapter H. F. 90. 12, concerning "Offenses against Public Policy"].
